Thursday's Meeting Summary

The meeting was called to order by **President Bob Gleichauf**. **Jim Thorpe** gave the invocation – reminding members that the work of Rotary continues in all seasons and through all kinds of weather.

Val Murphy-Goodrich introduced the guests and visitors: **Ahmed El-Moussa**, who was awarded the club 2011 Sisson Scholarship, and our speaker **Karen Patrick Davis** from MDOT Adopt -A -Highway. Ahmed briefly updated members on his academic career. After graduating from Fordson in 2011 he attended Wayne State University and received his undergraduate degree and is beginning medical school at Central Michigan University this fall. Both guests were then welcomed in the usual manner.

Bob announced that Rotary International President- Elect Sam F. Owori died unexpectedly on July 13 due to complications from surgery. Sam was a member of the Rotary Club of Kampala, Uganda for 38 years. Sam's term as the 108th President of RI would have begun on July 1, 2018. Current RI President Ian Riseley asked that all Rotarians keep Sam's wife, Norah, the Owori family and Sam's missions of friends around the world in our thoughts. Dave Anderson introduced today's speaker Karen Patrick-Davis from the MDOT Adopt-A-Highway Program. Karen has been with this program 38 years. Her office is in Taylor and she coordinates the program for Wayne County. This is her second time presenting to the club.

Prior to Karen addressing the members we all viewed the safety rules video. This video is available on the Adopt-A-Highway website: www.michigan.gov/adoptahighway. It is important for all participating groups to review the safety rules video as well as the brochure even if those groups have been in the program for several years.

Karen stated that the Rotary Club of Dearborn is the fourth longest serving group and, as of 2016, has collected 2007 bags and has volunteered 2017 hours in the assigned area along Telegraph Road.

Currently there are 2956 groups that have adopted approximately 6500 miles of highway. In Wayne County 61 active groups have adopted approximately 130 miles of highway. Two million bags of litter have been reported. Karen added that those numbers are actually higher because groups do not always submit their forms. The participating groups provide approximately 5 million dollars in benefits to the citizens of Michigan based on MDOT and/or contracted personnel doing the work.

Comments and questions followed. Some of this discussion centered on the fact that court assigned community service often assigns workers to highway clean up. This is not coordinated with the MDOT Adopt-A-

Highway Program. Some members shared stories and memories about being part of the first clean-up effort. A question was asked about whether social media has had any effect on changing littering behavior. Karen responded that, in her opinion, littering behavior remains a problem.

Karen was thanked for her presentation and the meeting was adjourned with the recitation of the 4 Way test.


