On behalf of the Wounded Warrior Ministry Center at Landstuhl Regional Medical Center, I want to thank you and the whole Dearborn Rotary Club for your generosity in assisting our wounded and ill warriors through the donation of 150 700 minute phone cards. We appreciate your expression of patriotism by giving back to our service members. It is citizens like you that exemplify the bigheartedness of humankind and we are truly grateful.

I am the Chaplain who oversees the Wounded Warrior Ministry Center at Landstuhl Regional Medical Center (LRMC), as such I am the person who receives all donations on behalf of Landstuhl Regional Medical Center Today I received the 150 700 minute phone cards from your organization. Again, thank you for your efforts on behalf of the Wounded Warriors and please thank whole Dearborn Rotary Club for your generosity in assisting our wounded and ill warriors through this donation. I am writing to ask you to re-shape your efforts. We receive approximately 700 patients each month evacuated from the theaters of operation. Our preferred practice is to give each Service Member a phone card. Our trends show us that 60 to 120 minute phone cards are optimal. If you could shape your purchases of phone cards to either 60 or 120 minutes it would help us as we distribute the good will that the Dearborn Rotary Club so graciously offer. I will work to come up with a couple of notes from Service Members who have received phone cards to assist you in further efforts.

As you may know, the WWMC started in October 2001 at the onset of Operation Enduring Freedom and continues today to provide service-members needed comfort items. Initially wounded military began arriving at LRMC dressed in operating room gowns. Our medical system is so responsive to our wounded that from the time a military member is injured downrange until he/she arrives at LRMC can be as little as six hours. The WWMC provides new, essential clothing/toiletry items which are available to all US service personnel, DOD employees, coalition partners, and US contractors regardless of race, religion, national origin or gender.
