Annual College Scholarship Award

Presented to two outstanding students attending a public or private high school, or enrolled in an Early College or Career Technical Education program in the Dearborn School District who through academic achievement, demonstration of leadership, community service and ethical standards exemplified by the Rotary 4-Way Test, is recognized with a \$4,000 scholarship award for each student's enrollment at an accredited college or university.

PROCESS

1. Applicant will pull application off the Dearborn Rotary website, prepare the application, and mail the application to (applications will not be returned):

2. Application will be judged by a panel of three Dearborn Rotarians who will be appointed jointly by the Presidents of the Dearborn Rotary Club and Dearborn Rotary Foundation.
3. The winner will be notified by mail and e-mail; other applicants will be notified by e-mail only.
4. The winners must download and submit the “Scholarship Funds Request Form” found on the www.DearbornRotary.org website under the “Scholarships” tab.
5. The winner will be invited to attend an evening Rotary Celebration Event in April to receive appropriate recognition.
